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**Annual Report 2024-25**

Aditya college of pharmacy has commenced working from the academic year 2006. The first batch of students has passed out in the year 2010. The intake of B.Pharm program is increased from 60 to 100 with PCI approval in 2011. In 2012, college affiliation was changed to JNTU Kakinada. The college was given permission to conduct Pharm.D program with PCI approval in the year 2014. College name has been changed from Sri sai Aditya Institute of sciences and technology to Aditya college of pharmacy in 2016 and the college secured PIO status to admit foreign students. ACOP is approved by UGC under sec 2f, PCI, AICTE, APSCHE, AISHE, recognized by government of Andhra pradesh and it is formerly affiliated to JNTUK. ACOP became an **autonomous** organization. ACOP certified with ISO and participating in NIRF since academic year 2016. ACOP also achieved education excellence award. ACOP provides good infrastructure for holistic development of students and faculty members. The college has started the post graduate courses like Pharmaceutical technology and Pharmacology (M. Pharm) from 2010. The college has started the Pharm.D Course from the year 2014.

The students of B.Pharm, M.Pharm and Pharm.D in ACOP are made to undertake projects/ internship/field works. Total 142 students undergone project this year. Out of that 107 are B.Pharmacy, 9 M.Pharmacy and 26 pharm.D students.

Realizing the importance of web based learning the management has provided a high speed internet laboratory for the students and faculty. ACOP offers Add on courses for the Students which help the

students to think out of the box. Total 7 courses were offered this year for students and 511 students were enrolled in it in this academic year. Total number of students admitted in the college for this year is B.Pharmacy is 100 ,Pharm.D is 30 M.Pharm 04 Total number of students for 24-25 is 134. Number of faculty 39. Mentor mentee ratio is 1:14.

Average percentage of full time teachers against sanctioned post is 100%. This year, 2 faculty awarded with Ph.D and 6 qualified in various universities. The college has 07 qualified Ph.D holders for this 24-25 academic year. ACOP also carries extension activities for sensitizing students to social issues. Total NSS activities carried out this year is 26. An appreciation certificate was formally issued by Dhanvantari Blood Bank in recognition of the Blood Donation Camp organized at the institution by the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit. An appreciation letter was received from SPARC NGO foundation for donating clothes to flood victims. The institution also received appreciation from VRO for conducting awareness on usage of helmets in Subhadrapeta. Received appreciation from Venkatapuram for conducting medical camp at Venkatapuram. Students also received appreciation certificates from Sri Kiran Eye Hospital in recognition of their voluntary participation in blood donation. During current AY, a sum of rs 1,31,458 was disbursed to faculty and students as incentives for publication, books/chapters, patents and innovative projects. During the current academic year, faculty members published a total of 31 research papers, 21 book chapters, and 5 books. In addition, students contributed significantly to the institution's academic output with 10 research publications.

There is huge collection of books and journals which are subscribed regularly. During the academic year, five new journals were added to the library's collection, bringing the total number of subscribed journals to 77 comprising 45 international and 32 national journals. The library also holds a collection of 1,463 distinct book titles, encompassing a total of 7,762 volumes. The institution is also registered for SWAYAM local chapter.

Total number of students benefited with scholarships this year is 12.

The students are given coaching in the III and IV year for the GPAT examination. Total 223 students were given coaching for competitive exams this year. Students qualified in PGE CET 11 students went for higher education are 12

During this academic year, a total of 16 webinars and 2 online Faculty Development Programs (E-FDPs) were conducted. Additionally, a two-day National Conference, CARE 2024, was successfully organized. Final year B.Pharm students were taken for industrial visit to Seldom pvt Ltd, Yanam, AMTZ, Vishakapatnam and Hetero labs, Nakkapalli. The institution has total 13 MOUs.

The institution has a transparent mechanism for timely redressal of student grievances including sexual harassment and anti ragging committee. No grievances for students and faculty were observed in this academic year. No cases were received under RTI act. NO cases were received by ICC and NO malpractice cases found. Total committees were present in the institution were 25. A new committee, titled the *Finance Committee*, was established during the current academic year to oversee and manage the financial matters of the institution.

Students of B.Pharm and Pharm.D from ACOP are placed in Dr.Reddys-6, Synergine-13, Biological E Ltd-2, CORRO-19, LAURUS-13, EPISOURCE-22, DIVIS-6, MEDITECHHIRE-10. Total 91 students out of which 74 of B.Pharmacy and 17 students of Pharm.D were placed with highest package 3.5 LPA. During the academic year, the Sports Committee successfully organized eight sports events within the institution. Furthermore, students achieved commendable success by securing eight prizes in various competitions conducted by other colleges. Total 12 cultural programs were conducted.

Alumni contribution received for this AY is 2,03,530/- Out of this, 33,566/- amount was spent to purchase balances for B.Pharmacy labs .

Aditya college of pharmacy established the IQAC officially on 4<sup>th</sup> July,2018.Right from the inception, IQAC has been an integral part in developing a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the overall performance of the college. It is committed towards quality enhancement in the institution. This year 2 meetings were conducted by IQAC. The institution participated in NIRF. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) conducted an orientation program on the preparation of course files for newly appointed faculty members. Additionally, it organized two faculty seminars: one titled '*AI Meets Drug Discovery*' and another on '*Research Excellence through AI*'. As part of its continuous quality enhancement initiatives, IQAC carried out a Student Satisfaction Survey, which helped identify key focus areas for institutional improvement. In response to the findings, a faculty training program on '*Teaching Pedagogy and the Role of Communication Skills*' was conducted to address the highlighted areas and enhance overall teaching effectiveness. IQAC conducts Academic & administrative audits each year to map all department functionalities towards the vision and mission of the college. Lab audit and Course file audit were conducted in this year.

The institution has conducted 3 programs under ethics committee. Accountability and duty concerning the code of behaviour, key steps for student on boarding program and ethics on equality of opportunity and respect. Two best practices implemented in the institution were 1.overcoming the myth surrounding prospects of pharm.D through experiential training and learning during clinical visits.  
2. Employment of female faculty members-A step towards women empowerment.



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
